- ★ The remainder of the session was devoted to discussion/review of the AMTE Standards for Mathematics Teacher Preparation Draft. President Livers thanked Marilyn Strutchens and Gary Martin for their work as members of the AMTE Writing Team and asked them to comment about the Draft document. Attendees then met in groups to review and give feedback. All suggestions from the AMTEA will be shared with the AMTE.
